### Track Reviews

Both tracks are constructed well, developing and building as they progress through the intro, verse and chorus. Normally I would say the intro for "1980" is a little long, but the intro itself develops quickly keeping the listener's interest, which is maintained throughout the track, good catchy chorus. The vocal performance is good. The tracks are pretty clever, encompassing a number of genres, which does help with the unique properties of your material.

### Artist Biography

Robert Billups aka Robbie B was born March 19<sup>th</sup> 1980, Ipswich, UK.

After writing songs for many years Robbie B now has material for five albums. He has had moderate success with this material so far. One track "Where Are You" gained well over 15,000 plays on Myspace.

In 2007 Robbie B also collaborated with a further three artists to form "B Squad", whom have giggered continuously from this period.

Robbie B has grown in popularity on the karaoke circuit, and was introduced to his future producer; Jonny S (Born Slippy Studios and who is a DJ in Liquid). This has resulted in selected tracks being featured on RADIO 102FM.

More recently in 2008 Robbie B finished material for a fifth studio album called "1980" and released this worldwide (on the digital sites). This album was very 80s influenced.

In 2008 Robbie B achieved interest from Scamp Music Publishing and they offered a publishing deal, however, the terms were not as desired and the deal was turned down.

The two featured tracks "1980" and "You Got Me Thinkin" have been reworked and produced for Robbie B's new EP. (The original versions appear on Robbie B's Studio Album "1980").

Earlier this year, The Student Director of Bournemouth University showed interest in Robbie B's music. This resulted in a 45 minute documentary being filmed over 4 days on the subject "*What It's Like For An Artist To Try And Make It In The Music Business*". This documentary titled "Robbie B 1980" will soon be commissioned for local TV.
