Middleman are a 3-piece indie / rock/ pop band from Kilmarnock, Scotland that formed back in 2000. They have become one of the stalwarts of the local music scene building up a fan base with their clever lyrics, subtle melodies and bounce around the room anthems. Their music combines varied genre styles that some find difficult to categorise. When asked about this, Wesley replied "*We have never tied ourselves to a certain style because we have so many influences*", "*We also like to let the lyrics mean something and be clearly heard*"

Most recently Middleman have won **The-Music.com Best Unsigned Song Completion 2007** with their track "*We Don't Wanna Go*".

In 2006 Middleman were also nominated in the BT DMA Awards for the Best Unsigned Act.

With a number of gigs performed over the last two years including being asked to support Dr Dot and her band "Bitchfest" in Berlin on November 9th 2006, and most recently playing an open-air gig at Kilmarnock's Dean Park Courtyard in early June 2007 to the delight of the audience.

Their song "Bad Charlotte" (now a fan favourite) made the tabloids in The Daily Record of Scotland (article below).

When asked "What message would you like to portray to your fans with your music", Wesley says "*When I look at the songs we write I want to inspire others to be assertive and portray self-empowerment, so if you want something, go get it and not be influenced by negatives saying that you can't achieve your goals. That being said, I would have to add that we're also about having a good time and not taking everything so serious - I like to make people laugh and be happy.*"

Middleman are aware of the challenges ahead and have come along way from winning The Rock Garden's Battle of the Bands back in 2004. The band members are fully committed to their music and are presently focusing of writing more material and expanding their ever-growing fan base.

Aguilera 'rude' says Charlotte after her first meeting with Christina

CRAZY Chick Charlotte Church has launched a scathing attack on pop beauty Christina Aguilera.

The teen soprano was disgusted by the Dirty girl's behaviour when they met up in California.

She said: "Christina is the nastiest celebrity I've ever met. We've got the same management in LA and I saw her in the office there. She didn't really do anything, but she was quite rude."

Meeting the American singer in the flesh was a disappointment for Charlotte, who had looked up to her as a youngster.

The first albums she bought were by Christina and Britney Spears.

But she admitted she has been shocked by Christina's raunchy videos.

She said: "That's hardcore. If she's okay doing it then fair enough, but I personally wouldn't want all my flesh on show. It's fine to be sexy, but after a point it gets sexual and seedy."

The singer has gone for a foxy look in the video to her new song Call My Name, which was out on Monday.

But while Charlotte has become an object of adoration for her thousands of male fans, there's only one she wants to impress - boyfriend Gavin Henson.

She said: "I don't see other men, I've got my man. I've never been happier."

Charlotte, who once sang for the Pope, has silenced critics by making the transition from classical to mainstream with surprising ease.

Her debut pop single, Crazy Chick, charted at No.2, while her album, Tissues and Issues, went top five in the album charts.

But the 19-year-old is still aiming high - and her next challenge is the coveted Christmas No.1.

She said: "What's the point in being a popstar if you don't go for the Christmas No.1? It would be cool to get one."

Charlotte is also hoping to headline a tour at some point next year. She said: "That would be my dream, to have my own tour. I really want to do it."

If her time on the road brings her back to Scotland, she might want to be wary of up-and-coming band Middleman.

The Kilmarnock based trio have written a song dedicated to Charlotte - and the lyrics may not go down too well with the Welsh fireball.

They include: "Voice of an angel, mind of a slut, My favourite award, you won the year's best butt."

"If you're looking for a bad boy, look no further, Take me home to tea and I'll slap your mother."

Frontman Kevin Wilson argues that Bad Charlotte - An Ode To Char portrays the singer in a good light. He said: "With all her negative press, we thought our nation's favourite naughty girl deserved her own ditty to show she's not really that bad."

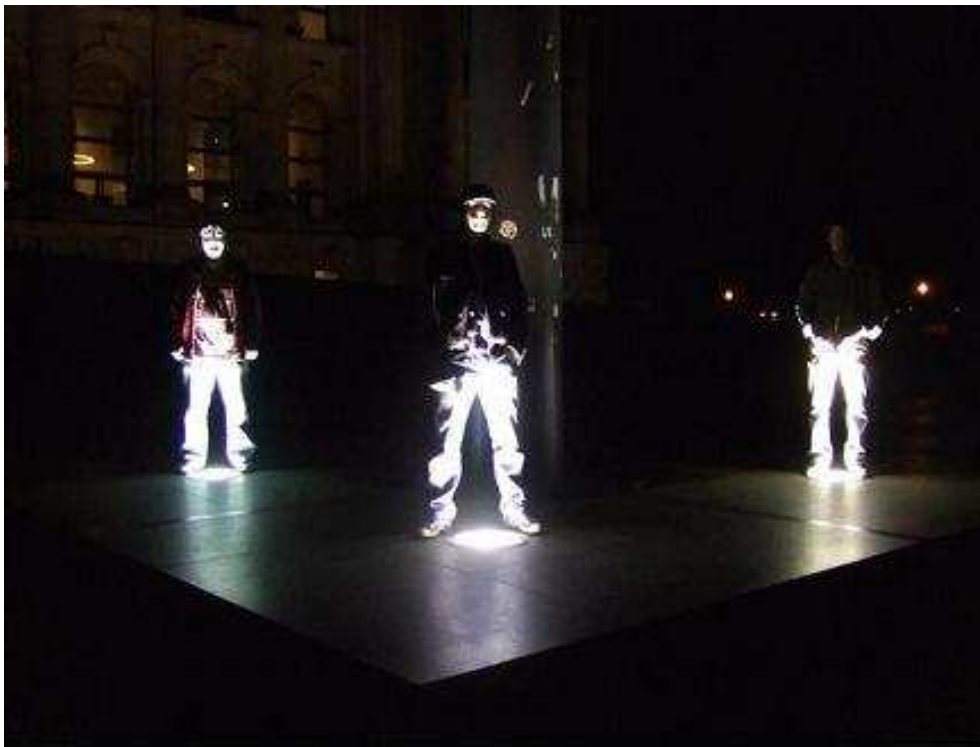
